The designer arrived in Dubai, rising with the achievement of being the first Nicaraguan and one of the few Latin Americans who has been present at the ARAB Fashion Week (Arab Fashion Week).



The Nicaraguan designer was appointed director of International Relations of Metropolitan Fashion Week, one of the most important fashion platforms in the United States. Bendaña is the first Nicaraguan to hold this position that will last two years and his mission will be to find designers and emerging talents or talents that are already positioned in the fashion industry such as Michael Cinco and Dolce & Gabbana to have an active participation during the fashion week in Los Angeles.
